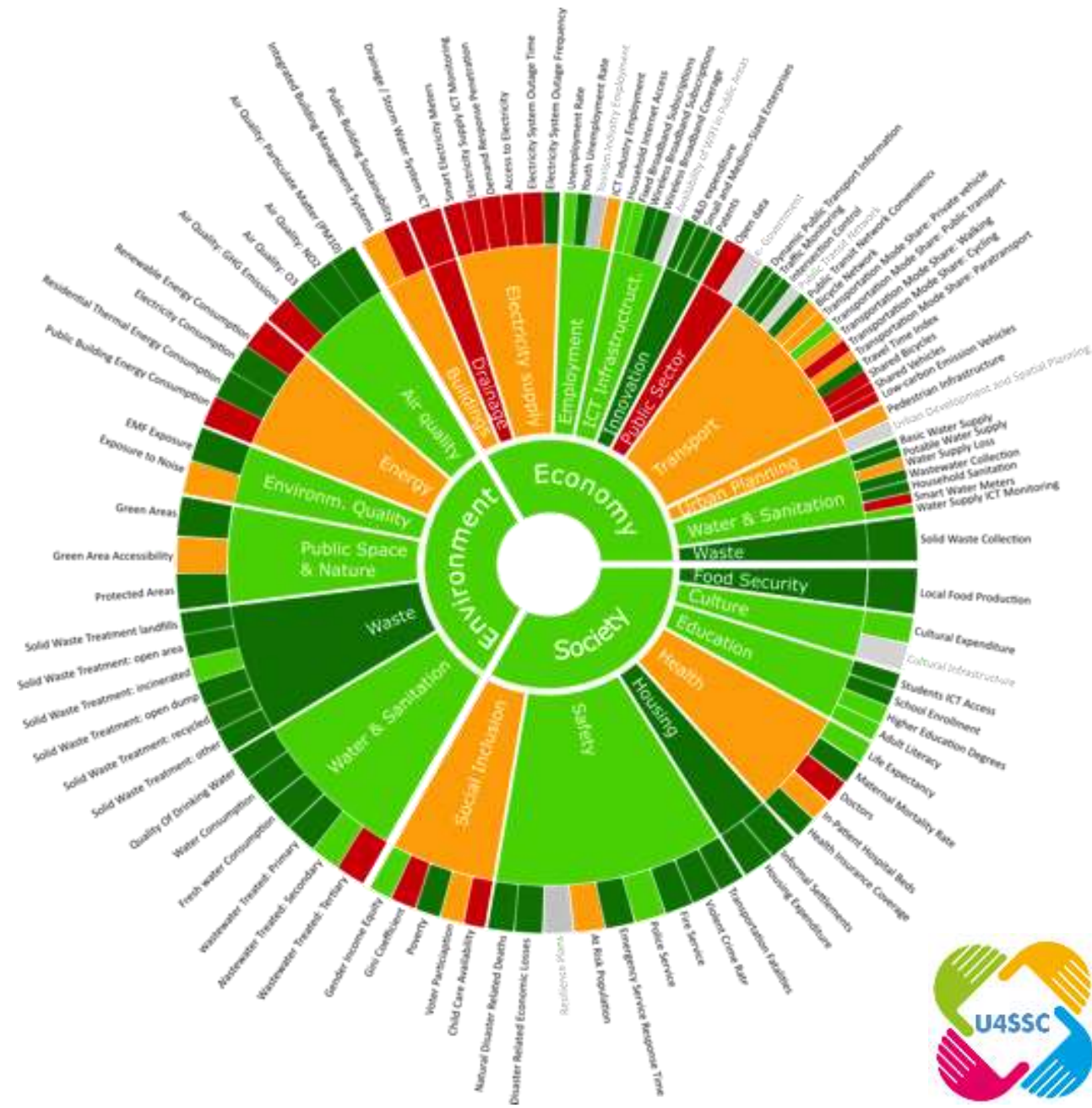


# SCORING OF KPIS

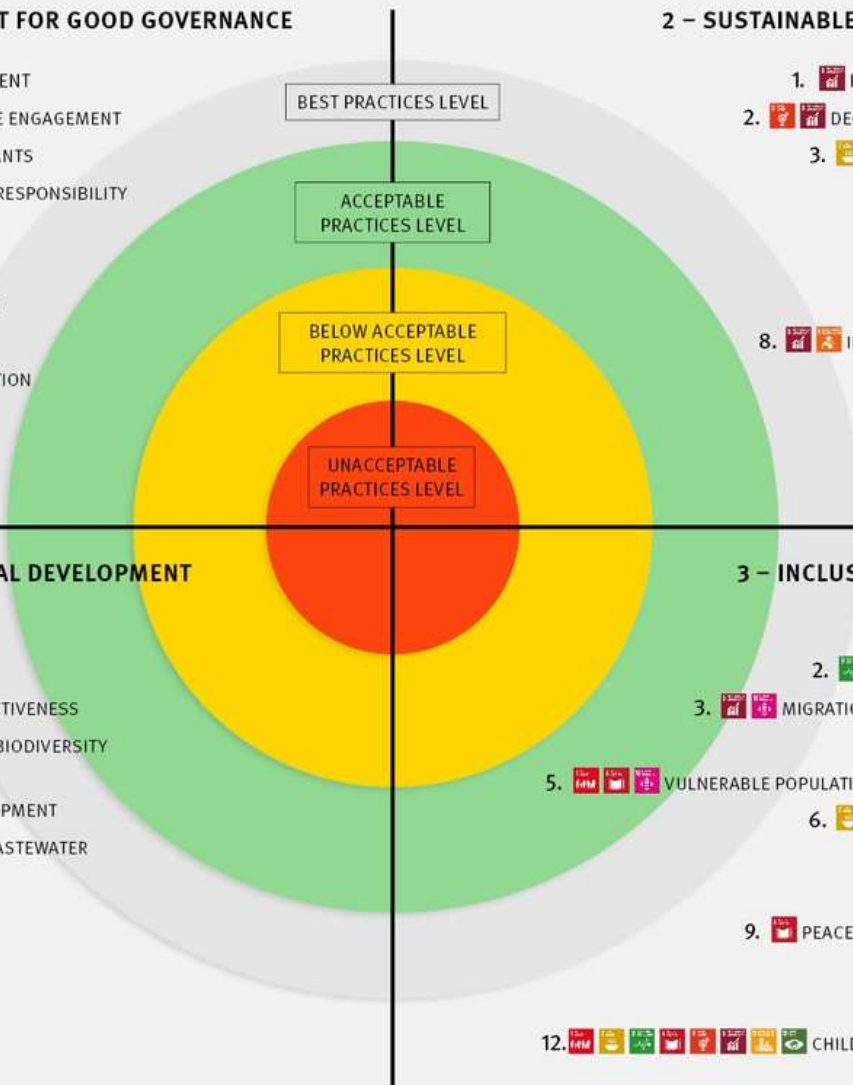
